

CLEARANCES

Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Law (CPSL) requires certain individuals to obtain clearances in order to be employed, be a resource parent (foster or adoptive), <u>or be a volunteer with children</u>. As we prepare to resume in person Sunday School classes & potentially other youth activities, we need to ensure that current clearances are in place for all of our volunteers working with children. Clearances are required for an employee or unpaid volunteer at a minimum of every 60 months from the date of the oldest clearance. We are required by law to ensure that clearances are obtained in accordance with the CPSL.
